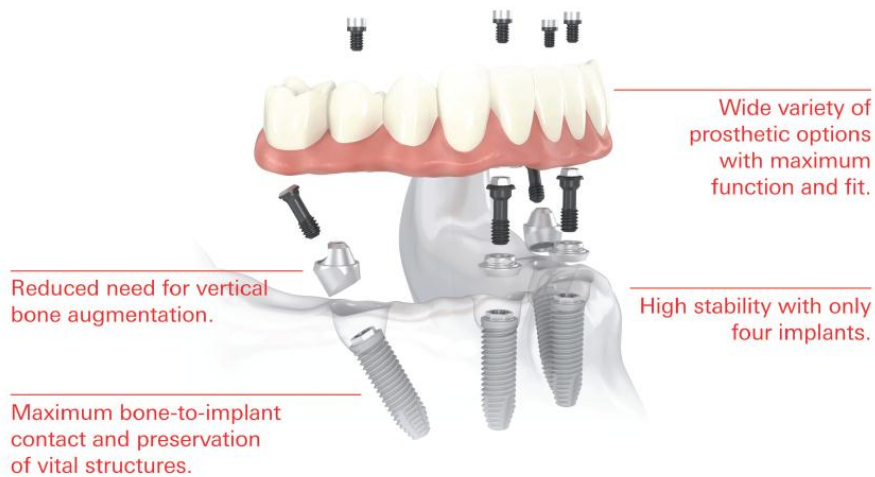

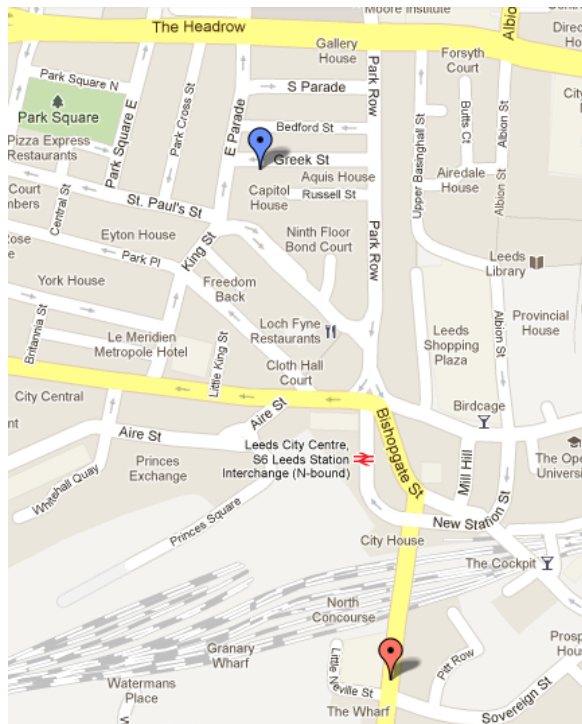
Golf
